- Complete all requirements for Core 40
Earn 2 additional math credits
Earn 6-8 world language credits
Earn 2 fine arts credits
Earn a grade of "C" or better in courses for Core 40
Have a grade point average of a "B" or better
Complete ONE of the following:
- Complete AP courses (4 credits) and corresponding exams
 - Complete IB courses (4 credits) and corresponding exams
 - Earn a combined score of 1200 or higher on the SAT critical reading and math
 - Score a 26 or higher composite on the ACT
 - Complete dual high school/college credit courses from an accredited postsecondary institution (6 college credits)
 - Complete a combination of an AP course & exam (2 credits) or an IB Standard Level course & exam (2 credits) and dual high school/college credit courses from an accredited postsecondary institution (3 transferable college credits)
